





**Total Non-Farm Employment Percentage Change Nov 2019 to Nov 2020** 






#### Percent Job Change Dec 2019 – Dec 2020






### Nonfarm Employment Change Missouri & Neighboring States










# Missouri Annual % Jobs Change 1990-2019






## Employment Change by Sector for the US & MO November 2019 – November 2020






# U.S. Domestic Migration by MSA Population 2010 to 2019



#### **Annual Change in U.S. Resident Population**





#### Projected Population Change 2019 – 2029 Ages 25-64







# Labor Force Participation Rate By Educational Attainment






# Adv Industry GDP vs Adv Industry Jobs % change 2014-2019












#### Fiscal Year 21 Revenue Outlook










#### Percentage change from peak employment in economic downturns




